Important Information for Existing DataFlex Users:

- 1 DataFlex 2023 - 23.0 uses different DLL component naming and/or a completely separate registry branch from DataFlex 20.1 (and earlier). You may install and use DataFlex 2023 - 23.0 on the same machine as DataFlex 20.1 (and earlier) without interference.
- 2 The WebApp Server components of DataFlex 2023 - 23.0 can coexist with previous revisions of the WebApp Server on the same machine without interference.
- 3 Changes that you have made in your DataFlex 20.1 development environment (registry settings that control utilities, editor customizations, etc.) will not be automatically detected or used by DataFlex 2023 - 23.0. When you are ready, you have the option to run the on-demand Import Studio Preferences routine from the Studio Tools menu. For settings that are not imported, you will need to duplicate those changes manually.
